BEGINNER PUPPY 4-6 MONTHS (BPUP)

(FRIDAY SHOW ONLY)

The BPUP competition shall be for dogs that are four (4) months of age and over, but under six (6) months on the day of the event. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the Country of origin. Professional handlers, members of their household, current assistants to professional handlers may personally exhibit a dog they own as "Exhibition Only" in the BPUP competition. "Exhibition Only" entries are not eligible to earn awards in this competition.

Dogs that are owned/co-owned by the forenamed a professional handler, member of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five (5) years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

- Minors (under 18 years of age) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the BPUP competition.
- Exhibition Only entries may not be changed to be eligible to compete for awards after the close of entries.

Non-Regular Classes For Single Dog/Bitch Entries

VETERAN (7 yrs & under 10 yrs) **VETERAN (10 years+)**

Castrated Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible for Veteran Classes at independent specialties and by virtue of winning the class, may compete for Best of Breed.

COURSING

For dogs and bitches that are AKC registered and are confirmed lure coursing champions or open field coursing champions. Titles may be from any recognized coursing organization. Spayed and Neutered dogs are eligible to compete in this non-regular class at this independent specialty. NOTE: Exhibitor must supply proof of eligibility for the class with entry. A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of View Points/Summary of the Title Progression for the dog can be printed out and is an acceptable form of confirmation of title. Dogs and Bitches will not be entered into this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form. First place winners are eligible for Best of Breed competition provided all AKC eligibility and requirements have been met. If entering online, confirmation of title can be emailed to MACDogShows@outlook.com with registration number clearly indicated.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed champions in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

RESERVE POINTS AVAILABLE

At each SANE Specialty, if the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, **provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's sex totals at least twice the number required for a five-point major, in the region in which the event is held.** No major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners.

SELECT DOG, SELECT BITCH, AND AWARDS OF MERIT

Select Dog and Select Bitch are recognized as the top quality of their sex after BOB and BOS have been awarded. As an Award of Merit is a club award and the Select is an official award of the AKC, the Select is of GREATER precedence than the Award of Merit.

Awards of Merit are for those Salukis considered for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and are chosen after the Select Dog and Select Bitch. Winners Dog or Winners Bitch are eligible, along with all other Salukis which, in the opinion of the judge, would, on another day, achieve Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. The judge, at his/her discretion, may award up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry to receive the judge's Award of Merit.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers*. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers meet the requirements for this competition. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled by an owner/handler eligible for the AKC National Owner Handled Series throughout the breed level competition for the point show. This includes the class competition and subsequent competition in the breed

ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition. If the replacement handler is an eligible owner/handler for that dog a change can occur. Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and winners of the non-regular classes.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

***A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*



BEST FROM THE BRED-BY EXHIBITOR CLASSES

After Best of Breed, Selects, and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred-By Exhibitor Dog and Bred-By Exhibitor Bitch, (Puppy and Adult) will compete for Best Bred-By Exhibitor. If Best of Winners is from any Bred-By Exhibitor class, that entry is automatically Best Bred-By Exhibitor.

BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR PUPPY CLASSES

After Best of Breed, Selects, and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Puppy Dog 6-9 months, Puppy Dog 9-12 months, Puppy Bitch 6-9 months, and Puppy Bitch 9-12 months, Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy Dog 6-12 months and Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Bitch 6-12 months will compete for Best Puppy. If the entry has been defeated by another puppy (Winners or Reserve), the entry is not eligible to compete for Best Puppy. If Best of Winners is from either the 6-9 month, 9-12 month, or Bred-By Exhibitor Puppy 6-12 month Class, that entry is automatically Best Puppy.

BEST VETERAN FROM THE VETERAN CLASSES

After Best of Breed, Selects, and Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of the Veteran Dog 7 years & under 10 years and Veteran Dog 10 years+ classes and Veteran Bitch 7 years & under 10 years and Veteran Bitch 10 years+ classes will compete for Best Veteran.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Saturday Show #1

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and, who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the

HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS & PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER & BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES & GUIDELINES.
