ENTRIES:

- ~ Entries will be accepted in a Random Draw from 09/09/2026 through 09/23/2026. After the Random Draw period, all entries will be processed in the order they are received.
- ~ Each judge is limited to 8 hours of MAX judging per day.
- ~ **ONLINE ENTRIES** can be made at <https://www.macdogshows.com/online-entries>. You will be asked if you will be paying by check or would like a STRIPE invoice to be sent. If you enter through STRIPE, a \$4.00 convenience fee will be charged. The \$4.00 convenience fee is **per dog, per day**.
- ~ **NOTE:** If you pay via STRIPE and you withdraw your entry prior to the closing date, you will receive a refund of your entry fee except for the convenience fee(s).
- ~ A Wait List will be established IF the hours of judging is reached. The Wait List will only be maintained until the trial closing date. An email will be sent to the exhibitor(s) if they did not get into the trial.
- ~ Both RACH & RAE classes are offered. Once the hour limit has been reached in either the Master, Excellent B, or Advanced B classes, these classes will be considered closed.
- ~ The UDX class is offered. Once the hour limit has been reached in either the Utility B or Open B classes, the UDX class will be considered closed.
- ~ Please indicate on your entry form if you are entering the RACH, RAE, or UDX class.

TRANSFERS:

- ~ Transfers will be allowed for the trials. All transfers will run at the end of their class, jump height. Transfers must be received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- ~ Transfers are allowed as follows:
 - ~~ Obedience Trials – Transfers allowed from Saturday to Sunday only.
 - ~~ Rally Trials – Transfers allowed from trial to trial (Saturday Trial 1 to Saturday Trial 2 and Saturday trial 1 or 2 to Sunday).
 - ~~ Transfers must be received 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

NO SMOKING:

- ~ NO smoking within 30 ft of any building which includes the doors or inside the building. This includes e-cigarettes, vapes, etc.

DOG EXERCISE:

- ~ The gated areas are off limits.
- ~ Please relieve your dog where indicated, pick up after your dog, and utilize the plastic bags provided.
- ~ Flexible leashes are NOT allowed. Your dog must be on a 6-foot leash or shorter at all times. No dogs are permitted off leash.
- ~ **Do not forget to pick-up after your dog.**

CHAIRS:

- ~ There will be no chairs ringside, except for stewards.

CATALOGS:

- ~ Only a limited number of catalogs will be printed. To be sure you will receive a copy, prepay for your catalog by including \$4.00 with your entry fee. To receive your prepaid copy, you can pick it up at the trial secretary's desk in Building B. No catalogs will be mailed. If you purchase a catalog at the trials, the cost will be \$5.00 per catalog.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES:

- ~ Cooked food will be available for a nominal donation. There are numerous fast-food restaurants within 5 minutes. Bring your own lunch, snacks, water, etc. Workers who are at the trial all day, will receive lunch. Check the Premium List to determine how many \$5.00 vouchers you can earn if you are a worker.

RINGSIDE:

- ~ Maintain a 6-feet distance between you, other exhibitors, and anyone else at all times. If you are a worker-exhibitor and crating inside Building B, you are responsible for being on time ringside. You will not be notified in advance by a steward.

TRIAL REGULATIONS ~ PLEASE READ

ENTRIES CLOSE AT THE TRIAL SECRETARY'S OFFICE, by 6:00pm, Wednesday, October 21, 2026, after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted. Make check payable to MAC Dog Shows LLC. Canadian exhibitors must have fees payable in US Funds.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of **\$30 to each returned check**.

ENTRY FORM MUST BE SIGNED by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telephone entries cannot be accepted.

OVERNIGHT deliveries requiring **NO** signature only. We cannot guarantee on-time arrival of entries via FedEx or other overnight services. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRY FEE INCLUDES AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF \$0.50 on the first entry only for each dog, each day in Obedience. **An AKC Event Service fee of \$4.00** will be required for each regular class each dog entered in Obedience. The AKC Recording Fee of \$4.50 per first entry in the Rally Trial plus \$4.50 per all additional entries. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the fee is collected on all classes and dog is entered in, excluding non-regular classes. These fees are included in the entry fee. (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competing by action of the Trial Committee.

NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE RETURNED if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control OF CATC. CATC will not be responsible for loss or damage to property while on show site.

CATC will not be responsible for errors made on entry forms. Please double check entry prior to sending. Owners are responsible for errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT carefully, the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

DECLINATION OF ENTRIES, CATC, may decline any entries & may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause & no one shall have any claims against CATC. or any official thereof.

NO ENTRY shall be accepted which carries any conditions regarding its acceptance.

THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents & employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES & a judging program will be made as soon as possible after entries close by email. Should such acknowledgment not be received within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary at 330-518-9920 or MACDogShows@outlook.com.

BITCHES WHO COME IN SEASON OR ANY DOG WHO HAS OCCURRED AN INJURY, after the closing date, may have their entry fees refunded less \$6.00 per entry upon written certification by a Veterinarian. Notification must be made to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the Trial. The written certification from the Veterinarian, can be faxed to Mary at 330-599-7185.

WHEN THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED in more than one class, only the highest score will be used for the top awards in Trial or top awards of a breed.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler is solely responsible for having the dog ringside when scheduled. Dogs need be at the trial only at scheduled time of judging, and may leave immediately after, unless required for further judging.

ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED at the Trial, or they become the property of CATC. None will be mailed.

ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the warm-up ring. All handlers are asked to clean up after their own dog.

Section 27. Limitation of Entries and Methods of Entry

Random Draw. When using the Random Draw method, entries are treated equally without regard to date/time received or any other criteria during the Draw Period. Accepting Entries After the Random Draw Time Period. Accepting Entries After the Random Draw Time Period.
