NON-REGULAR CLASSES (SINGLE DOG ENTRIES)

Veteran Dog/Bitch Classes: for Dogs and Bitches 7 years and under 10 and a class for those 10 years and over, both sexes. The winners of these classes are eligible for Best of Breed, provided they have not been defeated in another class. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered.

Sled Dog Classes: for Dogs and Bitches. See Page 9 for eligibility requirements. Entry form MUST be accompanied by either a copy of the Sled Dog Title Certificate from the Siberian Husky Club of America (or foreign equivalent) OR the SLED DOG CLASS FORM (page 9).

NON-REGULAR CLASSES (MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES)

At the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog / Brood Bitch Classes: Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) shown with two of their offspring. Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excuses. Off-spring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch – offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class: For two Siberian Huskies with at least one owner in common. Both dogs must be entered in another class to qualify for the additional class entry fee.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

**NOVICE CLASS:** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition, if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

**OPEN CLASS:** This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

**MASTER CLASS:** This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

**NOTICE:** Junior Handlers must include their **AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER** on each entry.

You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC at 919-233-9767.

**BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR:** The best Bred by Exhibitor will be chosen from the winners of the Bred by Exhibitor Puppy Dog Puppy, Bred by Exhibitor Adult Dog, Bred by Exhibitor Puppy Bitch, and Bred by Exhibitor Adult Bitch classes following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday, both shows.

**BEST PUPPY:** The best Puppy will be chosen from the winners of the Puppy Dog 6-9 months class, the Puppy Dog 9-12 months class, the Puppy Bitch 6-9 months class, the Puppy Bitch 9-12 months class, the Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy Dog class, and Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy Bitch class following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday, both shows.

**BEST VETERAN:** The best Veteran will be chosen from the winners of the Veteran Dog 7-10 years class, the Veteran Dog 10 years & over, the Veteran Bitch 7-10 years class, and the Veteran Bitch 10 years & over following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday, both shows.

## **AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.



**DON'T FORGET TO CHECK THE OWNER-HANDLED BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF ENTERING THIS COMPETITION.**

All dogs that are owner-handled & are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book, & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner\*. Professional handlers, household members, & assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, & winners of the non-regular classes.

- If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed & be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.
- If the Best of Breed winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition & the Best of Opposite Sex is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex from the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition & both the Select Dog & Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner Handled Best of Breed from the Selects & any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible for AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, excuse all eligible champions & non-regular class winners of the same sex & then choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including thing eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog that competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

\* *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years.*

## **FOUR TO SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION (BPUP)**

(Saturday Show #2 and Sunday only)

### **Section 1 ~ Classifications**

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

### **Section 2 ~ Entry and Eligibility**

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler, members of their household, or current assistants to professional handlers may compete for awards in this competition but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

## **PEE WEE CLASS SPECIAL ATTRACTION**

(Saturday Show #2 and Sunday only)

### **Requirements and Classification**

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meet the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- The dog shown must be a Siberian Husky registered with AKC.
- The safety of both the dogs and juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. An additional lead, provided by the Club, will be at the Judge's table. At the Judge's discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

**SLED DOG CLASSES**

(Saturday p.m. and Sunday only)

**Rules**

- 1.) Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky. (Eligible under Chapter 15, Sec.1 of the AKC Rules regarding Registration Dog Shows).
- 2.) There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of the Show Chair, additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degree Program.
- 3.) If entered in a class for which full entry was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the sled dog class. If not, the entry fee to exhibit solely in Sled Dog will be a non-regular entry fee.
- 4.) To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class, the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
  - (a) During the previous racing season, the applicant must have completed ten (10) heats with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat on snow or 3.5 miles per heat with rigs on dry land, or the total miles per season not being less than forty-eight (48) miles. The 48 miles can consist of a combination of both snow and dry land races. All races must be under the direction of a Recognized Race Giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
  - (b) Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee if the 5 years of proof of competition records are sent in.
  - (c) Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- 5.) Dogs must be intact to exhibit in the Sled Dog Class.  
 A list of the races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Secretary when entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown if challenged. The Show Secretary shall request the4 following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each dog’s AKC Registered Name, AKC Registered Number, Sex, Race, and Date of Race, miles per heat and total miles – or a five (5) year proof certificate – or copy of the Sled Dog Degree.
